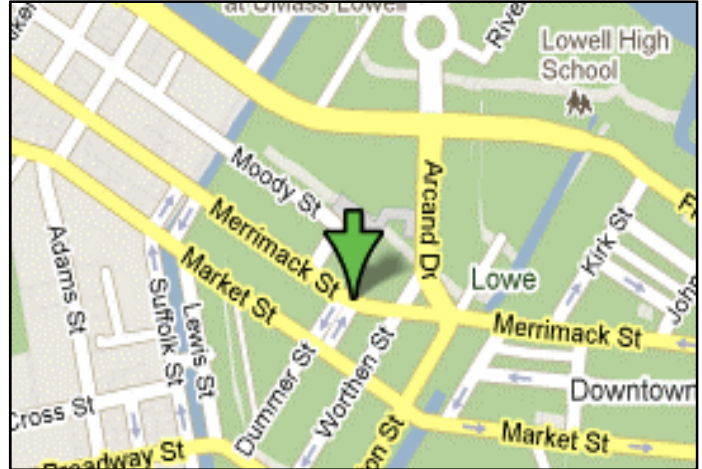

Directions

The **Pollard Memorial Library** is located at 401 Merrimack Street near City Hall. There is ample parking.

From Middlesex Village

- Head northeast on Middlesex Street toward Pratt Avenue
- Continue on Pawtucket Street
- Turn Right on Merrimack Street (Library on the left)

From I-495

- Take Exit 35C (Lowell Connector)
- Then take Exit 4 for Plain Street and follow signs for the Lowell Connector
- Take 5B (end of connector) to merge onto 3A/Thorndike Street
- Slight left onto Thorndike Street
- Turn left onto Dutton Street
- Turn left at Market Street
- Turn right at Cardinal Oconnell Parkway
